You were a true Evangelist and you loved the Lord. You were a woman of prayer and led many to Christ through your leadership of the 'Humble Training Prayer Band'. We witnessed many miracles and persons being healed from their infirmities. I can recall the beginning of many prayers as they mostly started with the words "Oh Zion when I think of thee, I wish for pinion like a dove, and mourn to think that I should be so distant from the place I love". You were a pillar of strength to me in my darkest and most troubled times. You were not just my sister but also my prayer partner and best friend. The love between you and I led my daughters Princess & Lenora to take care of you when I could no longer care for yourself. There were so many sayings that you shared with us, two of which we would never forget: "God is still on the throne and He will remember His own" and "Though burdens may press me and trouble distress me, He'll never leave me alone". These sayings were paraphrased from 2 of your favorite hymns, 'Never Alone' and 'God is Still on The Throne'.
